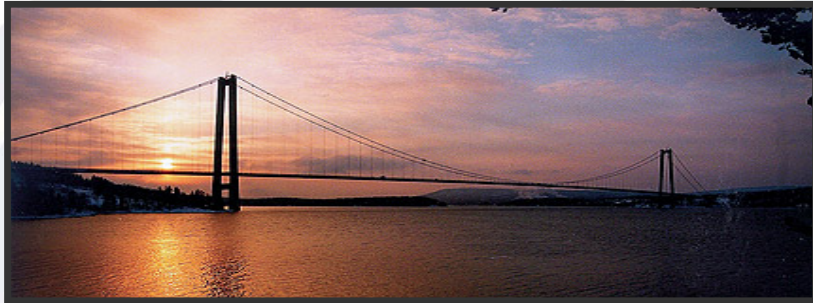

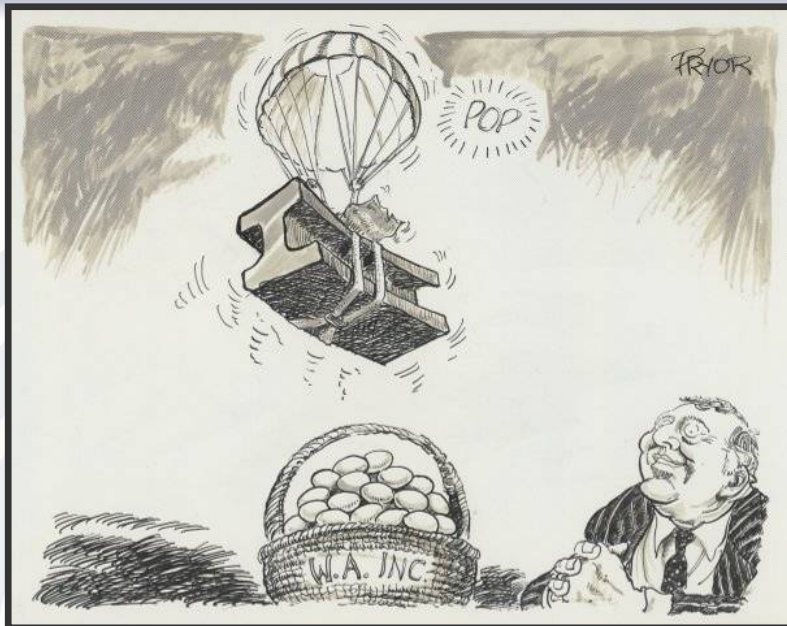

## WA Inc Royal Commission

- Legislate the respective roles of Ministers and their advisers, and public sector CEOs and their staff.
- Public sector to establish a code of ethics and agencies to establish codes of conduct.
- Public officers to follow those codes.
- Public Sector Standards Commissioner to monitor compliance.
