So what can be done to raise standards and improve an organisation's professionalism and conduct? At this lunchtime briefing, Marian Birrell will discuss the critical leadership and management issues. She will outline:

- **Why the PSCU was established, and how it works.**
- **A diagnosis of cultural frameworks: cultural issues and work required to embrace a modern management style that incorporates openness, responsibility, accountability, nurturing & support.**
- **What Marian has discovered about: limitations of disciplinary systems; striking the right balance in serious cases; issues arising out of 'personal conduct' cases (child abuse, drug taking, attitude etc.); the challenge of finding good internal and external investigators.**

Marian Birrell is Manager Professional Standards Unit, New South Wales Ambulance Service, and has worked directly in professional conduct and disciplinary area for several years. She is a solicitor with a lengthy career in public service, including involvement in areas of criminal justice, victims of crime, child protection, and has worked for various 'watchdog' bodies including the ICAC and Community Service Commission. Her experience has been at both the policy and operational levels.
